**Subject:** NEW – Military Transfer Assurance Guides Announcement

With the recent IT CTAG update, institutions will need to make submission for all new CTANs if they have equivalent courses and get those courses approved by the IT CTAG Review Panel. Once the appropriate CTANs are approved, the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Network staff will add to the course equivalency reporting system for the MTAGs.
