As of January 21st, 2016 seven of Ohio’s public colleges and universities offer a course similar to **CTAIR005 Private Pilot Theory**. Due to FAA regulations, some institutions have limitations on how they can apply credit for courses similar to CTAIR005. The chart below is designed to provide guidelines on how this credit may be applied towards different programs across the offering institutions. Students are encouraged to speak with a representative of the program at the institution to which they plan to transfer credit earned from CTAIR005.
